## SPRING 2019 WILDFACT EDITION

- **35%:** Percent of UA students in 2002 who reported being single and not dating.
- **50%:** Percent in 2018 who reported being single and not dating.
- **29.5 and 27.4:** Median ages of American men and women, respectively, for age at first marriage (highest/oldest on record).
- **18.8:** Births for every 1,000 adolescent females ages 15-19 in 2017, resulting in a record low teen birth rate in the U.S.
- **11.8:** Abortions per 1,000 women of childbearing age (15-44) in 2015, the lowest level in the U.S. since *Roe v. Wade* legalized abortion nationwide in 1973.
- **1/3:** Proportion of people who use online dating sites but who have never actually gone on a date with someone they met online
- **1/4:** Proportion of straight couples who now meet online
- **2/3:** Proportion of gay couples who now meet online
- **51%:** Percent of UA students who used Campus Health in the past year.
- **99%:** Percent of UA students who used Campus Health and would recommend it to a friend.
- **66%:** Percent of UA students who had received the HPV vaccine, which protects against cervical, penile, and oral cancers, as well as genital warts.
- **39%:** Percent of UA students who read SexTalk in the past year.
- **1 in 2:** Odds that a sexually active person will get an STD by age 25. Most won't know it.
- **2/3:** Proportion of chlamydia diagnoses in the U.S. that are reported among individuals between the ages of 15-24.
- **\$0:** Cost of a sample pack of condoms at UA Campus Health's Free Condom Friday event, which takes place every Friday during the Fall and Spring semesters from 12-2pm.
